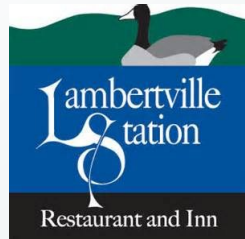

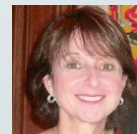
Chris Bogdan

DIRECTIONS

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From Philadelphia/Southern New Jersey: Take I-95 North, staying in the right lane when going over the bridge into NJ. Take the first exit after going over bridge (Route 29 Lambertville/Trenton) and follow Rt. 29 North for 10 miles. Make a left onto Bridge Street (Route 179) in Lambertville. The Inn at Lambertville Station will be on the left just before the bridge to New Hope, PA.

From Northern New Jersey: Take Route 202 south, and take the last exit before the toll bridge to PA (Route 29 Lambertville). Bear left onto Rt. 29, continue to first light, then turn right onto Bridge Street (Rt. 179). The Inn at Lambertville Station is on the left just before the bridge to New Hope, PA.

From Points West: Take the PA Turnpike (I-276) east to Exit 28, Route 1 North. Take Route 1 North to I-95 North. From here, follow directions above for Philadelphia/Southern New Jersey.

From Points East: Take Route 195 West past the New Jersey Turnpike entrance. Route 195 West will become Route 29 North. Follow Route 29 North for approximately 18 miles (when you pass the I-95 entrance you're about halfway there). Make a left onto Bridge Street (Route 179) in Lambertville. The Inn at Lambertville Station will be on the left just before the bridge to New Hope, PA.

PARKING INSTRUCTIONS
